Tracking Christ from the Beginning - Faithfulness and Faith "Moses . . . he wrote about Me." Jesus, John 5:46 (also, Luke 24:44)

Genesis 25:12-31:55, generations (toldot) of Ishmael and Isaac (portion, whole to 35:29).

Testing, Trials, Suffering and Growth (review)

- Types 1) "<u>tribulation</u>, affliction" Romans 5:3;
 2) "<u>testing</u>/tempting of faith," James 1:2-4, 12-13; 1 Peter 1:6-7; Matt 6:13; Luke 4:13; 3) "discipline," Heb 12:4-11.
- Growth same end results: "perseverance, proven character,"
 "endurance . . . perfect (mature)" "peaceful fruit of righteousness."
- Perspective 2 Corinthians 4:16-18, "momentary, light" and result in "eternal weight of glory;" also, Rom 8:17-18, no comparison to the glory to come.

Summary of Events, 25:12-31:55

- Chapter 25:12-18 generations (toldot) of Ishmael; "he settled in defiance of all his relatives."
- Chapter 25:19-34 generations (toldot) of Isaac; births of Jacob and Esau; Esau sells birthright; *read* 19-34, *especially notice* 23, 28, 34.
- **Chapter 26** thumbnail of Isaac's life- promises renewed, blessing and trouble in Gerar and Beersheba, *read 3-5, 24*; covenant with Abimelech, king of Philistines.
- Chapter 27 Jacob gets Isaac's blessing, too; *read* 27-29; priest/prophet of family, blessing given "by faith," Hebrews 11:20.
- Chapter 28 Jacob blessed by Isaac and God; dream at Bethel, renewal of promises, read 13-15, 19.
- Chapter 29:1-30:24 Jacob in Paddan-aram- Jacob is deceived now, himself, and marries, *read 20*, *30*; competition of Leah and Rachel for children (29:31-30:24).
- Chapter 30:25-31:55 Jacob in Paddan-aram- prosperity and friction with uncle and cousins, "So he fled with all that he had" (31:21 NASB); covenant with Uncle Laban.
