Genesis 5:1-11:26, generations (toldots) of Adam, 5:1; Noah, 6:9; Shem, Ham and Japheth, 10:1; Shem, 11:10.

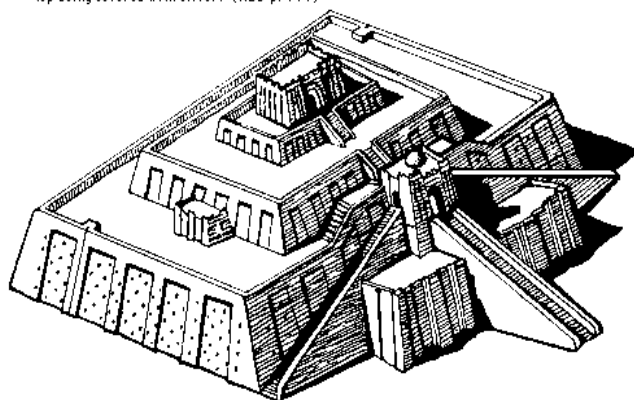
Summary of Events

- Line of Seth, 5:1-32.
- Flood, 6:1-9:19; read **6:5-13**, 17-18, 22; **7:4-5**, 11-12, 17-24; **8:1**, 4, 14-16, 20-**9:1**, 18-19.
Observations: God and sin, He preserved the righteous, He is faithful in mercy.
- Seth blessed, Canaan cursed, 9:20-27.
- Lines of Shem, Ham and Japheth, 10:1-32.
Observations: Nimrod, 10:8-12, prelude to chapter 11; Peleg, 10:25, another prelude; “languages,” retrospective by Moses.
- Languages and scattering “over the face of the whole earth,” 11:1-9.
Observations: “east” repeatedly; Shinar and Babylon; archeological discoveries; independent unity; what they feared came – Proverbs 10:24.
- Line of Shem, 11:10-26, ages reduce by halves.

A reconstruction of the temple-tower, or ziggurat, as built by Ur-Nammu, king of Ur, c. 2100 BC. The platforms were different colours (black, red, blue), the temple at the top being covered with silver. (NBD p. 111)

Sin and Righteousness

- Cause of sin? Fear.
 - law, Romans 5:20; 7:5; 1 Corinthians 15:56
 - death, Hebrews 2:15
- Two-fold solution
 - eternal salvation, 1 Cor 1:30
 - temporal salvation, same principles
Holy Spirit, 2 Cor 3:6; Galatians 5:16-23; Romans 8:1-7
faith, 2 Cor 5:7, Gal 2:20
cross- 2 Cor 4:7-12
